Weather #4: D W N I

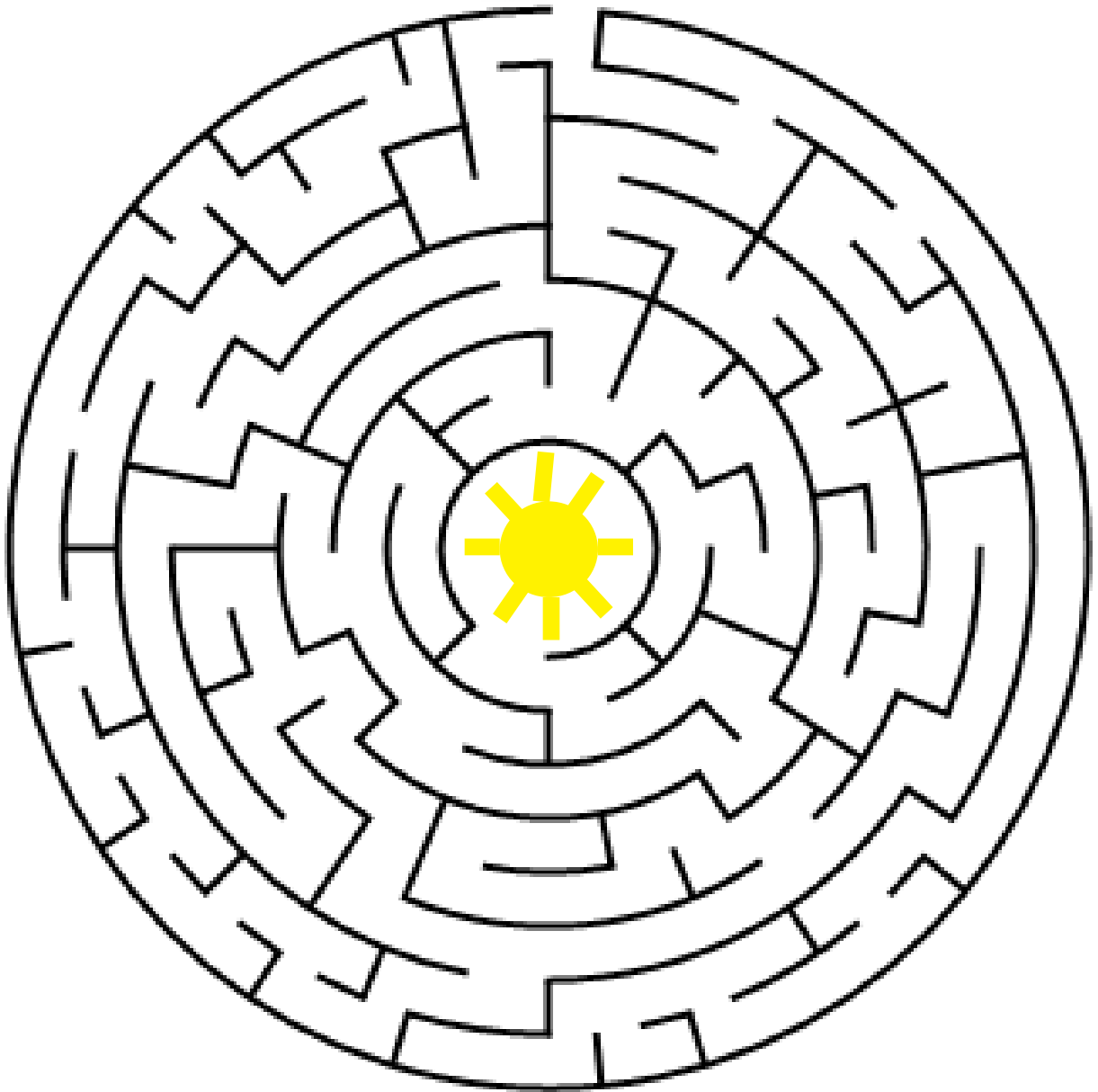
Weather #5: O G F

Weather #7: H D T R E U N

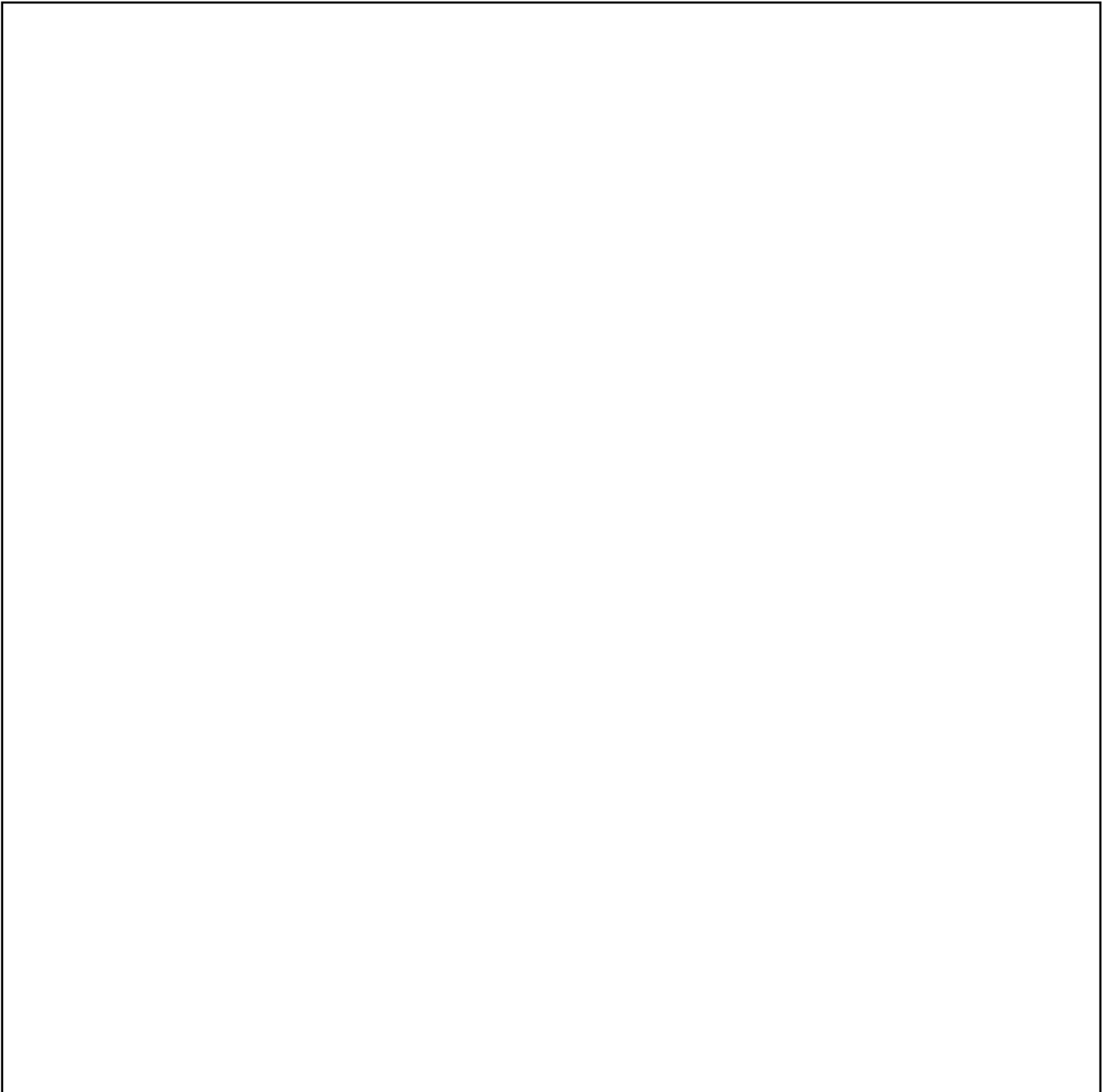
Activity 2: Helping Froggy

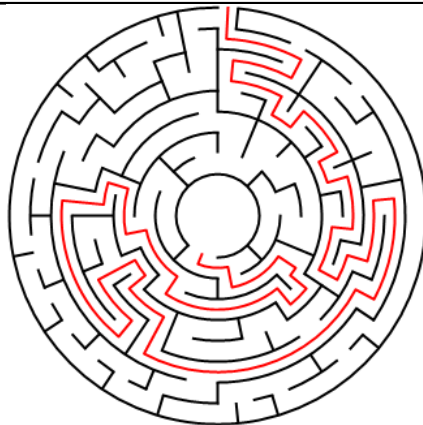
Activity 4: A Poem To Read
